Davis campus emeriti/ae may arrange with their department to retain their UC Davis email address and Sacramento campus physicians/faculty emeriti may do so if they have a business purpose to retain their email account. Davis campus staff may apply for a complimentary service that will forward their *mailid@ucdavis.edu* email to an external email address (e.g., *name@gmail.com*). Email accounts for health system retired staff are disabled upon retirement due to HIPAA regulations.
