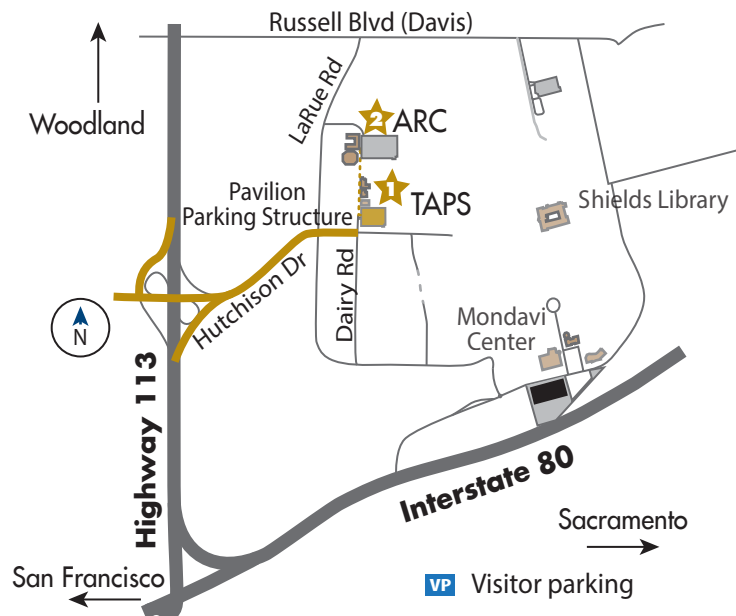


## UC Davis Retiree Center Retiree Resource Fair

Directions to Transportation Services (TAPS) for retiree parking permit and proceeding to Activities and Recreation Center (ARC) for Resource Fair



### 1 Driving/Parking directions:

**Driving from Sacramento or San Francisco:** From Interstate-80, take exit 70 to merge onto CA 113 North. Take exit 27 (UC Davis/Hutchison Drive), bearing right towards campus as you exit. Drive straight on Hutchison past LaRue Road, then turn left onto Dairy Road and right into the Pavilion Parking Structure.

**Driving from Woodland:** From CA-113 South, take exit 27 (UC Davis/Hutchison Dr). Turn left onto Hutchison Drive. Cross over the freeway, continue straight on Hutchison Drive past LaRue Road, then turn left onto Dairy Road and right into the Pavilion Parking Structure.

**Driving from Davis:** Drive south on LaRue Road (Anderson Road in Davis). Turn left onto Hutchison Drive, then turn left onto Dairy Road and right into the Pavilion Parking Structure.

### Parking & walking to TAPS:

Free parking for this event will only be on levels 3 through 6 of the Pavilion Parking Structure. A Retiree Center volunteer will greet you at the entrance of the parking structure to give you an event parking permit which will be valid until noon. Please proceed to levels 3 through 6. After parking, proceed to the northwest corner for the elevator and/or staircase. At ground level, exit out of the structure and walk north along the path to TAPS (follow the event signs).

### 2 Walking/riding directions from TAPS to ARC:

**Walking:** Exit TAPS and turn right (north). It is about a 200-yard walk to the north end of the ARC.

**Riding:** A courtesy shuttle will be making continuous rounds between TAPS and the ARC. Look for a row of folding chairs at either end and signs to indicate the two shuttle endpoints.

**If you already have your parking permit,** you may park closer to the event, next to the ARC, in Lot 25. (See Star 2)
